Code of Conduct for Players, Parents and Coaches

Players

Thank you for being a player within North Vancouver FC (NVFC). We ask that all our players commit to the player agreement and code of conduct.

- 1. I deserve and will encourage "good sporting conduct" from fellow players, coaches, officials, and parents at all times.
- 2. I will remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- 3. I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol; and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer games.
- 4. I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- 5. I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, officials, other administrators, and spectators with respect always, and I expect to be treated accordingly.
- 6. I will concentrate on playing soccer and giving my best effort.
- 7. I will always play by the rules and within the spirit of the game.
- 8. I will always control my temper and I will not retaliate.
- 9. I will always exercise self-control.
- 10. I will make every effort to attend and be on time for all practices and games. If I must be away, I will let my coaches know well in advance.
- 11. Always give my best effort at every game and practice because my team depends on me.

Parents / Guardians

Thank you for being a parent within North Vancouver FC (NVFC). We ask that all our parents commit to the parent agreement and code of conduct.

- 1. I will encourage good sporting conduct by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials and administrators at all times.
- 2. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 3. I will support the coaches, officials and administrators working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 4. I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.

- 5. I will remind my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and spectators with respect.
- 6. I will always be positive.
- 7. I will allow the coach(es) to be the only coach.
- 8. I will not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches.
- 9. I will not come onto the field for any reason during the game and will enjoy the game from the spectator side of the field.
- 10. I will not criticize game officials.
- 11. I will explain to and support my child to abide by the Player Agreement/Fair Play Code that he signed at the beginning of the season.
- 12. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 13. I will support my child and his team by making a commitment to ensure that my child arrives to all practices and games on time and in the case of his absence, will advise the coaches well in advance.
- 14. Familiarize myself with all club policies including playing time guidelines.

Team Officials / Volunteers

Thank you for being a volunteer team official (coach, manager, assistant) within North Vancouver FC (NVFC). We ask that all our volunteer team officials commit to the team official agreement and code of conduct.

- 1. I will never place the value of winning before the safety and welfare of all players.
- 2. I will always show respect for players, other coaches, and game officials.
- 3. I will lead by example, always demonstrating fair play and good sporting conduct.
- 4. I will be knowledgeable of the laws of the game and teach these rules to my players.
- 5. I will never use abusive or insulting language. I will treat everyone with dignity.
- 6. I will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour, regardless of the situation.
- 7. I will not use or allow the use of anabolic agents or stimulants, drugs, tobacco, or alcohol by any of my players at any games or practices.
- 8. I will follow all club guidelines and policies, in particular minimum playing times.
- 9. Youth have a greater need for example than criticism. I will be the soccer role model.
- 10. I will always conduct myself in a positive manner.
- 11. I recognize that coaching is motivating players to produce their best effort, inspiring players to learn and encouraging players to hold their heads high win or lose.
- 12. I recognize that a team officials' actions on sidelines during games shall be always in the spirit of good sporting conduct. Profanity, profane gestures, arguing, inciting disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated by NVFC.
- 13. I consent to a Criminal Record Check (CRC) and understand that all of my support staff must be prepared to do the same. I will ensure that the CRC is completed by the timelines indicated by NVFC (the "Club").
- 14. I will be available to speak with both parents and players, outside of game time, if they have questions or concerns.

I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices remembering that young players have other interests and obligations.
